- Round 3:** You will be given one of the core verbs (below) that you will be asked to conjugate. For an extra point, you can put the word into a sentence. You will be provided with a small white board and marker to help you for this round.
- Round 4:** You will be given a word that you will be asked to put into a sentence or will be given a sentence that you will be asked to translate into Daḡota or English. You will be provided with a small white board and marker to help you for this round.
