2026 CRAFT VENDOR RULES & REGULATIONS

- No application will be considered for review without the following: Completed 2025 Vendor Application, \$150.00 fee per booth and detailed list of goods to be sold. Incomplete applications or lack of payment will not be considered and returned.
- Craft vendors must list names of all people authorized to work in the booth. Craft booth workers not listed will not be permitted to work.
- Submission of application is neither an offer nor a guarantee of space. Application is subjected to approval of the Veteran Pow-wow Committee. Notification of acceptance or denial will be confirmed by phone.
- Craft vendor booth for 10' x 10' space if you need more space you need to purchase 2 spaces.
- Deadline for registration is October 30th, 2026. Late applications may not be accepted.
- This is considered RAIN, WIND, or SNOW that prohibit your travel to the pow-wow.
- Vendor set-up time begins any time after 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 14, 2026. All booths must be open for business by 4:00 p.m. Saturday, November 14th, 2026. Any vendor that does not arrive by Saturday, Afternoon, Grand Entry time will forfeit their reserved space.
- Any vendor who provides false or misleading information regarding their business, merchandise, products or services will be excluded from all future Pow-wows.
- The Veteran Pow-wow Committee will supply one 8' banquet table with 2 chairs.
- The use of alcohol, drugs, or weapons of any kind will not be tolerated and are grounds for cancellation of any contract and removal from the D.E.C.
- The Lower Sioux Indian Community, its committee & Pow-wow staff are not responsible for any losses or damages due to fire, theft, disputes, or acts of nature.
