**2023 CRAFT VENDOR RULES & REGULATIONS**

- No application will be considered for review without the following: Completed 2023 Vendor Application and detailed list of goods to be sold and \$50.00 fee. Incomplete applications will not be considered or returned.
- Craft vendors must list names of all people authorized to work in the booth. Craft booth workers not listed will not be permitted to work.
- Submission of application is neither an offer nor a guarantee of space. Application is subjected to approval of the Veteran Pow-wow Organizers. Notification of acceptance or denial will be confirmed by e/mail.
- Craft vendor booth for 10' x 10' space.
- Deadline for registration is October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Late applications may not be accepted.
- This is considered RAIN, WIND, or SNOW that prohibit your travel to the pow-wow.
- Vendor **set-up time begins any time after 8:00 a.m.** on Saturday, November 12, 2023. All booths must be open for business by 12:00 p.m. Saturday, November 11, 2023. Any vendor that does not arrive by Saturday, Afternoon, Grand Entry time will forfeit their reserved space.
- Any vendor who provides false or misleading information regarding their business, merchandise, products or services will be excluded from all future Pow-wows.
- The Veteran Pow-wow Organizers will supply one 8' banquet table with 2 chairs.
- The use of alcohol, drugs, or weapons of any kind will not be tolerated and are grounds for cancellation of any contract and removal from the D.E.C.
- The Lower Sioux Indian Community, its organizers & Pow-wow staff are not responsible for any losses or damages due to fire, theft, disputes, or acts of nature.
